## NOT YOUR GRANDMA'S BRUSSEL SPROUTS

### Ingredients

- 1 pound Brussels sprouts, guartered
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 2 teaspoons garlic powder
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ teaspoon pepper
- 2 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese

#### Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees F.
- 2.Lay Brussels sprouts on baking sheet or oven safe skillet and drizzle with olive oil. Season with salt, pepper and garlic powder. Toss to coat.
- 3. Bake 10 minutes, shake the pan to turn and bake for an additional
- 4.8-10 minutes, until crisp and golden.
- 5. Remove from oven and sprinkle with grated cheese.
